**Métis Nation-Saskatchewan Standing Committee on Education –  
Early Learning Child Care and Child and Family Services**

**WHEREAS** the Métis Nation-Saskatchewan (MN-S) Provincial Métis Council (PMC) has created the authority for the establishment of Committees and adopted Terms of Reference for the MN-S Standing Committee on Education – Early Learning Child Care and Child and Family Services; and

**WHEREAS** the MN-S Standing Committee on Education – Early Learning Child Care and Child and Family Services would be mandated to identify the current needs of the MN-S citizens and work with stakeholders towards improving early learning supports for Métis children. It would also participate in the development of a Canada-wide Early Learning and Child Care Framework to guide renewed programming approaches that could better support the early learning and child care distinct needs of Métis Nation children and families. It will identify, direct and advise as to how these needs can be met, including through a Métis Nation-specific component of the Framework. The Committee will also explore the reach, accessibility and delivery of current federal initiatives for Métis families; and

**WHEREAS** it is the responsibility of the Executive and PMC to establish membership of the Standing Committee;

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that members be appointed to the MN-S Standing Committee on Education – Early Learning Child Care and Child and Family Services, at a future PMC meeting.
