### **Setting the Date for the Virtual Métis Nation Legislative Assembly**

**WHEREAS** Article 3.10 of the *Constitution of the Métis Nation – Saskatchewan* authorizes the Provincial Métis Council (PMC) to set the date and place for each sitting of the Métis Nation Legislative Assembly (MNLA);

**WHEREAS** the current public health restrictions in place in Saskatchewan due to COVID-19 prevent the holding of an in-person meeting of the MNLA; and

**WHEREAS** it is in the best interests of all Métis citizens that the MNLA meet virtually rather than in-person to protect the health and safety of all participants;

**BE IT RESOLVED** that the Métis Nation – Saskatchewan PMC set February 20 and 21, 2021 as the dates for the next sitting of the MNLA; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the sitting of the MNLA on February 20 and 21, 2021 be held virtually in a manner that will allow all members of the MNLA to participate in discussion and vote on resolutions before the MNLA, and will permit Métis citizens and other authorized individuals to observe the proceedings.
