Guidelines and Budget for the Emergency Repairs and Renovation Program

WHEREAS the current Métis Nation – Saskatchewan (MN-S) Emergency Repairs and Renovation Program (ERRP) does not meet the definition of “core housing need” for reasons including inter alia:

- a) The current maximum household income to be eligible is \$150,000.00;
- b) The current maximum forgivable loan is currently at \$15,000.00; and
- c) Cosmetic renovations are currently acceptable expenses;

WHEREAS an adjudication panel currently reviews and recommends applications to the ERRP for approval;

WHEREAS revised guidelines that meet the definition of “core housing need” (the “New Guidelines”) were submitted at this meeting on December 11, 2020, and have been recommended for the Provincial Métis Council’s (PMC) approval;

WHEREAS the ERRP 2019/20 fiscal year budget of \$2,875,000.00, representing \$2,500,000.00 for program funding and \$375,000.00 for administration has been fully expensed;

WHEREAS a proposed four year budget of \$12,075,000.00 for fiscal years 2020/21, 2021/22, 2022/23, and 2023/24 (the “Four Year Budget”) as part of a five year plan was presented at this meeting on December 11, 2020;

WHEREAS the aforementioned Four Year Budget, as submitted at this meeting, has been recommended for the PMC’s approval;

BE IT RESOLVED that the PMC hereby approves of the New Guidelines, as submitted at the December 11, 2020 PMC meeting, which shall include inter alia the following noted changes:

- a) The maximum household income to be eligible will be \$100,000.00;
- b) Grant amounts will be calculated on a case-by-case basis to address health and safety concerns, capital replacement items and senior adaptation;
- c) The revised Emergency Repair Program will be administered under the MN-S immediately;
- d) The Adjudication Panel will no longer be utilized; and
- e) Backlogged files will be reviewed under the new program design;

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BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the PMC approves, substantially in the form presented at the December 11, 2020 PMC Meeting, the proposed Four Year Budget of \$12,075,000.00 in the following allocations:

- a) \$3,450,000.00 for fiscal year 2020/21, representing \$3,000,000.00 for program funding and \$450,000.00 for administration;
- b) \$2,875,000.00 for fiscal year 2021/22, representing \$2,500,000.00 for program funding and \$375,000.00 for administration;
- c) \$2,875,000.00 for fiscal year 2022/23, representing \$2,500,000.00 for program funding and \$375,000.00 for administration; and
- d) 2,875,000.00 for fiscal year 2023/24, representing \$2,500,000.00 for program funding and \$375,000.00 for administration; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the appropriate officers of the MN-S be and they hereby are authorized and directed to take all actions and execute all such documents as they deem necessary or appropriate to effectuate this resolution.
