### **Introductory Clauses to PMC Resolutions**

**WHEREAS** the Provincial Métis Council (PMC) directed at their meeting on March 10-11, 2022, that all proposals for the PMC's consideration should include reference to the distinctive identity, culture, language and values of Métis people; and

**WHEREAS** the PMC also wants resolutions to reflect the cross-ministerial cooperation of proposals from the MN-S government, consistent with the mandate letters given to each Minister upon their appointment;

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that all ministerial resolutions submitted for consideration by the PMC will begin with the following two clauses:

- 1) "WHEREAS the government of the Métis Nation - Saskatchewan (MN-S) will include distinctiveness processes based on our identity, culture, values and language, inclusive of knowledge keepers, Elders, youth and distinct resources" and
- 2) "WHEREAS the [*relevant Ministry's name*] works across all MN-S ministries to create a collaborative process to review new and existing programs".
