Portfolio Reassignments

WHEREAS Articles 2.4 and 4.4(b) of the *Constitution of the Métis Nation - Saskatchewan* (the “*Constitution*”) confer upon the President the sole discretion to assign Ministerial portfolios, subject to the approval of the Provincial Métis Council (PMC) and ratification by the Métis Nation Legislative Assembly (MNLA);

WHEREAS Article 2.4 of the *Constitution* further mandates that the assignment of Ministerial portfolios is restricted to members of the MNLA;

WHEREAS President Glen McCallum determined it is in the best interests of the Métis Nation – Saskatchewan that certain Ministerial portfolios be reorganized and reassigned to promote an efficient and responsive government; and

WHEREAS on June 28, 2022, the President directed that the Ministerial portfolios be reassigned, effective the same date, and until such time as the PMC confirms its approval of the same at its next duly held meeting – to be ratified at the next MNLA;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the PMC hereby confirms its approval of the following Ministerial portfolio re-assignments and Ministerial appointments as directed by President McCallum on June 28, 2022:

- Culture and Heritage: Minister Ryan Carriere
- Economic Development and Tourism: Minister Brent Digness
- Early Learning and Child Care and Post-Secondary Education: Minister Tim Roussin
- Housing and Infrastructure: Minister Loretta King
- Women and Gender Equity: Minister Tammy Mah.
