Funding for the Emergency Repair Program

WHEREAS the Métis Nation – Saskatchewan (MN-S) recognizes the distinctiveness of Métis identity, culture, values and language - inclusive of Knowledge Keepers, Elders, Youth and distinctive resources – which is incorporated into proposals and decisions of the Provincial Métis Council (PMC);

WHEREAS the Ministry of Housing works across all MN-S Ministries to create a collaborative process to review new and existing programs;

WHEREAS the demand for the Emergency Repair Program (ERP) reopened on October 11, 2022, with an additional \$2 million for new applications, and the uptake for the program was totally committed within seven days as a result of citizens waiting for the program to reopen with new program funds; and

WHEREAS the Métis Housing Strategy has a budgetary carry-over of funds from the past three fiscal years which can be reallocated to the ERP;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the PMC is requested to approve the reallocated funds of \$4 million from the Métis Housing Strategy to the ERP for the remainder of the 2022-2023 fiscal year, to continue making funding available for the emergency housing needs of citizens through an established application process.
