Métis Nation-Saskatchewan Standing Committee on Constitution Reform

WHEREAS the Métis Nation-Saskatchewan (MN-S) Provincial Métis Council (PMC) has created the authority for the establishment of Committees and adopted Terms of Reference for the MN-S Standing Committee on Constitutional Reform; and

WHEREAS the MN-S Standing Committee on Constitutional Reform would have the mandate to examine legislation and study matters relating to legal and constitutional matters generally, including constitutional issues, legislative structuring, electoral matters, and legal issues pertaining to its mandate, federal-provincial relations, and creation of a judiciary; and

WHEREAS it is the responsibility of the Executive and PMC to establish membership of the Standing Committee;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that members be appointed to the MN-S Standing Committee on Constitutional Reform, at a future PMC meeting.
