### **Funding for the Emergency Home Repair Program**

**WHEREAS** the Métis Nation – Saskatchewan (MN-S) recognizes the distinctiveness of Métis identity, culture, values and language - inclusive of Knowledge Keepers, Elders, Youth and distinctive resources – which is incorporated into proposals and decisions of the Provincial Métis Council (PMC);

**WHEREAS** the Ministry of Housing works across all MN-S Ministries to create a collaborative process to review new and existing programs;

**WHEREAS** the demand for the Emergency Repair Program (ERP) has exceeded approved available budget and has been on hold since April 1, 2022;

**WHEREAS** the program requires an additional \$4 million for applications received before April 1, 2022; and

**WHEREAS** an additional \$2 million is requested to re-open the ERP on October 11, 2022, until funding is fully expended, and as such, the ERP will be closed to new applications for the remainder of the fiscal year;

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the MN-S PMC approve additional funding to the ERP to a maximum of \$6 million for the remainder of the 2022-2023 fiscal year:

- a. A maximum of \$4 million for existing claims up to April 1, 2022;
- b. A maximum of \$2 million for new claims received after October 11, 2022.
