Funding for the Saskatchewan Housing and Homelessness Conference

WHEREAS the Métis Nation – Saskatchewan (MN-S) recognizes the distinctiveness of Métis identity, culture, values and language - inclusive of Knowledge Keepers, Elders, Youth and distinctive resources – which is incorporated into proposals and decisions of the Provincial Métis Council (PMC);

WHEREAS the Ministry of Housing and Infrastructure works across all MN-S Ministries to create a collaborative process to review new and existing programs;

WHEREAS the homelessness population is growing across Saskatchewan, especially for the Métis and Indigenous populations. In 2022 Saskatoon reported a 15% increase, Prince Albert reported a 36% increase, and Regina reported a 41% increase; and

WHEREAS the Ministry of Housing and Infrastructure is seeking to plan and host the first two-day Saskatchewan Housing and Homelessness Conference in March 2023, including leaders and experts in the Housing and Homelessness sectors;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the MN-S PMC approve up to \$500,000 to host a Saskatchewan Housing and Homelessness Conference in March 2023.
