Ministerial Reassignments

WHEREAS the Métis Nation – Saskatchewan (MN-S) recognizes the distinctiveness of Métis identity, culture, values and language, inclusive of knowledge keepers, Elders, Youth and distinctive resources, which is incorporated into proposals and decisions of the Provincial Métis Council (PMC);

WHEREAS the MN-S works across all MN-S ministries to create a collaborative process to review new and existing programs;

WHEREAS Articles 2.4 and 4.4(b) of the *Constitution of the Métis Nation – Saskatchewan* (“*Constitution*”) confers upon the President the discretion to assign Ministerial portfolios, subject to the approval of the PMC and ratification by the Métis Nation Legislative Assembly (MNLA);

WHEREAS Article 2.4 of the *Constitution* further mandates that the assignment of Ministerial portfolios is restricted to members of the MNLA;

AND WHEREAS the Education Ministerial Portfolio will be reorganized in order to address long-term challenges for effective design and efficient delivery of services that meets the needs of our citizens;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Ministerial Portfolio appointments for Post-Secondary and Education, Early Learning and Childcare and Constitutional Reform be made by the President as follows:

- Post-Secondary and Education (K-12): President Glen McCallum
- Associate Minister of Post-Secondary and Education (K-12): Wendy Gervais
- Early Learning and Childcare: Sherry McLennan
- Associate Minister of Constitutional Reform: Secretary Lisa McCallum.

FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED that Wendy Gervais as Associate Minister of Post-Secondary and Education will assume the role as Chair of the Gabriel Dumont Institute Board of Directors.
